FINDING MEANING IN LIFE

Your client says to you, "I am so confused! I want to do something very special in my life. I want to make a difference. I want to be doing something that I absolutely love, that I am passionate about. And of course, I want to make plenty of money, I want to be appreciated and loved. I want to live in peace. Help me figure out my life's purpose."

So let's explore what Resonance Repatterning offers in answering this question?

First, I will give a few definitions of terms. There is a difference between life's mission and life's purpose. We have many life's purposes. Personally, my life purpose includes supporting my clients in transforming their lives, supporting my child in his journey, being a caretaker for my loved home and many other roles. Life mission, on the other hand is core. It is that what I came into this world to do, whether or not I know what it is.

A group of people can work on the same mission or it can be done singly. For me, my life mission is—in my own unique way, to make this world a place of peace, love and harmony. I have my own unique way of

accomplishing this mission. And, I have a feeling that many of you have this same mission, each in your own unique way.

Each of us made a choice to come into this world. Consider what Chloe Wordsworth says in the introduction of the *Abundance Repatterning in the Transforming Meridian Patterns* book. There are millions of sperm swimming to the egg and only one sperm penetrates the egg. Fifty percent of all fertilized eggs do not implant in the womb. Fifty to eighty percent of all fertilized eggs produce twins. It is against all odds that we are here, having a body. At any point in that very challenging process of being conceived, implantation, and through the process of being born, we could have left, but we did not. We chose to stay—and for what purpose?

It is an interesting point that each of us comes into this world with unique gifts and has a special purpose. It is as if we forgot what we came here to do. It can take a very long time to figure out what we are meant to do with our gifts. I, for one, am 63 years old and am still acquiring more and more clues as to my mission and life purposes. I am still very impatient with the process. I want it all now. I want all the information, and I want to be doing it all now.

Back to our client. Here are some suggestions on the process of finding and living your life purpose from a Resonance Repatterning point of view:

1. The Lists lead us to the heart of the issue. We have books and books of lists. Using these lists, we zoom into the heart of any issue with the exact right question or identifying the exact right noncoherent belief/emotion/unmet need. It is a brilliant format.
2. Accept what is. Carin Block says that we have very little to do with changing our fate. Fate has to do with our country, our family and all of those with whom we interact. She tells us to bow to fate and say, "I agree. I am only the little one." Resonance Repatterning presents our issues in a way that makes it easy for us to accept what is. What is happening in our clients lives, no matter how much they might resist it, must be part of their purpose and mission.
3. Identify earlier experiences and ancestral beliefs. Freeing our clients from past trauma is certainly necessary for building a happy future. In fact those past

experiences, whether they happened in present lives or are inherited patterns, can be used as building blocks for manifesting. Take Mary, a client who was worried about not making enough money, and afraid she would not survive. She did a Carin Block meditation called "Family Secrets." Her grandfather was a poor man who ran a candy store. His wife died. He could not afford to care for all of his children. He kept his two sons and sent his two daughters to an orphanage, a terrible place where there was not enough of anything and ruthless childhood abuse. Everyone knew how horrible it was for the girls, but no one spoke of it. What was there to say? There could be no greater poverty than to have to place one's children in harm's way. As this story was revealed to my Mary, she discovered that she did not need to repeat her family's pattern of poverty. Furthermore, she discovered that her life's purpose is to support children in being all that they can be by holding support groups for them. Since that session she has done many things to manifest that purpose.

4. The most valuable part of Resonance Repatterning is to be you, the practitioner—you, the witness; you the cheerleader; you the questioner. The protocol is client centered. We don't have the answers; we don't even have the question, actually. Our clients have the questions and the answers within themselves. What we do have is our ears and our hearts. Sometimes our clients know what they want to do in life, but they fear the change and the risks that manifesting what they truly want requires. Again you are there to support that transformation.

As we develop our selves to be clear channels, love and self-confidence can flow easily to our clients and they can more clearly see what is to be released and what is to be embraced. We can show them their brilliance so that they can choose for themselves what they truly want to do out of the myriad choices open to them in their spiritual path. We can help them find the freedom and the courage to do what needs to be done to manifest what belongs to them.

A friend of mine said of her counselor: "She took me firmly by the chin, and looking into my eyes she said, 'Do not play small with your life, the bolder course is better.'" That's our job, showing our clients The Path.

WHAT'S MOM GOT TO DO WITH IT?

I could say that most of my clients have mother issues — but it feels more accurate to say that they had mothers with issues. Mothers with issues are so pervasive that I find myself wanting to shout to the world, “ANY one with a healthy mother out there?”

It can be a tough place to navigate. Mom is IN THERE. She has ALWAYS been in there. She has issues. Her issues leave deep marks. Surrendering, forgiving, and appreciating the truth of her marks are only the beginning. This is the **conception** (if you will) **of the new you**.

Eventually your work with her allows you to form a healthy bond of detachment and to kiss her goodbye. Now you stand alone, a stranger in a strange land. Now you are only your core: a will to live, the fire of life shining in the watery dark, a divine spark of life's mystery. You are essence; flowing, undefined source, feeling your way along.

In this dark unknowable place, we take the first step of our life mission. We find a place to stand where we practice trusting — on our own terms. We feel our needs and hold them in compassion. We learn that we are safe in change and transition, in not knowing and in knowing. We stop judging and start growing.

We nurture our dreams with small steps. We feed ourselves with process and explore. We discover that transition and process work better with good daily habits that build strong foundations. We give ourselves healthy doses of disciplined personal care. Before we know it, there WE are and we are doing it! We are living our life mission. There is a new inner mother IN THERE and she is so loving it.

She is well connected, and gave great ideas for people to write articles for us. At the same time, Kimberly was keeping the World Peace Hologram afloat and moving. She spent enough hours on this project to have been a part time job. All this, of course, without pay. Thank you Kimberly.

Sally: How have you served in Resonance Repatterning--as a member, a practitioner and a board member?

Kimberly:

- 1) Chair of World Peace Hologram Project.
- 2) Board of Directors member for Repatterning Practitioners Association
- 3) Repatterning presenter at Virtual Conference for 2008 and 2009.
- 4) RPA Journal Committee member and contributing quarterly author.

Sally: Tell me about your work with World Peace Hologram.

Kimberly: I continue to serve as the Chair and Liaison for World Peace Hologram to establish and expand its presence through its programming and communication. This includes web update newsletter communications with participants, practitioners and social media venues on Twitter, Facebook and Wordpress.com. It also means working with practitioners to assist them with

posting and protocols as they arise as well as working with Carolyn Winter, our web designer/administrator, in this project. I will continue to post to the RPA Journal.

- 2009: World Peace Hologram was organized to provide 6 months of personal topics and 6 months of world peace topics. The program included a calendar with 49 sessions including practitioners from Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, United Kingdom, Canada, Mexico and the United States. A team approach with leader and monthly groups with Practitioner's Manual was created including guidelines for blogging, teleconferences and team collaboration. A photographic calendar was created with solicited photos from photographers and practitioners. Online monthly Peace Café's were recorded that evolved into recorded peace meditations for 2010. Survey of practitioners and participants in April 2009 gave overall response to need for streamlined program and website. I worked with beta testers during the summer including a marketing person and practitioners for web formatting/language to enhance streamlining along with Carolyn Winter.
- Web presence expanded to Twitter, Facebook and Wordpress.com
- World Peace Hologram was registered with the UN as a peace project working with the goal of international peace.
- I applied and received a free press release based on our status and vision for calendar launch in 2009.
- 2010: The program is a 12-month program based on Maslow's Pyramid and Integral Psychology with recorded peace reflections and Journey to Peace Journal. I created the journal to integrate personal goals. Impromptu sessions such as those done for earth events from the beginning of 2010 are still in progress/process with the potential for practitioners to respond to global issues.

Sally: Working with you in the Journal Committee, you were very connected with other practitioners and brought to the committee great ideas.

Kimberly: It has been an honor to work with the board in the transition to the web for the Journal and web classes. I appreciated the collaboration with teams, and the ability to think outside of the box. I enjoyed writing articles and providing content for the journal for the themed topics and World Peace Hologram. I have had the opportunity to connect with practitioners all over the world through World Peace Hologram, sometimes in the middle of the night for scheduling purposes or questions.

Sally: What is the secret of your success?

Kimberly: I have a deep respect for this work and what it has to offer the world. Personally and professionally, I feel great devotion and passion for its expansion.

Sally: How is your life changing and what is attracting you now?

Kimberly: I continue to be attracted to peace projects. This past year I took classes with a focus on communication and conflict resolution. I am drawn to the work of Marshall Rosenberg. I have had an outline for a book for a few years now with peace as a topic, and am hoping to flesh it out in the coming year.

Sally: What is something no one knows about you?

Kimberly: What comes to mind is that people might not know that I am a Person-Centered Expressive Therapist. They also might not know that I specialize in working with children with special needs as an educator, counselor and consultant. I've taught at the university level on these topics, and have worked for more than two decades with families and children.

Sally: What could help World Peace Hologram continue to grow?

Kimberly: The web work and visioning/organization of Carolyn Winter and myself who spend significant hours in web design and programming speaks to the continued need for support of time and energy as the program moves forward. The need for more help and expansion of web updates and communication through different venues is needed to enhance the program.

Welcome to Robyn Nielsen,

Nancy: Congratulations on successfully completing all the requirements for certification! Please tell us about yourself. What you do for a living and what is your background and education?

Robyn: I was born in 1947 and raised in Anaheim, California, the second of four children. I attended parochial schools taught by nuns and I was a sensitive, unhappy and difficult child. I received a good education but never the really important answers I was looking for from a religious point of view. After completing high school, I wanted to attend college and major in Philosophy. My mother wouldn't hear of it. She wanted me to become a singer and actress and felt very strongly that philosophy would pollute my religious upbringing. (As if being an actress wouldn't!) So instead, four months after graduation and turning 18 I got married and shortly after joined the Hippie Movement. That was quite an education, although a dangerous one. During that time I divorced, remarried and had two children in my second marriage. Sometime later I took a college course in accounting, which enabled me to have the means to support myself through the services of accounting and bookkeeping when needed.

How did you learn about Resonance Repatterning®?

In my early fifties a lot of negative emotions began surfacing. I did a training called Bad Cluster Elimination that identified hidden abuses. I relived the trauma of Satanic Ritual Cult Abuse at age seven and eight as well as sexual abuse at an earlier age. My unhappy and difficult life made much more sense, except now the trauma was releasing and interfering with my quality of life all the more. After trying to get relief through several different modalities and practitioners, I still couldn't get resolution, especially with

the ritual abuse programming. At age 59 I came into contact with a young woman of my same faith who had moved here to San Diego from Indiana and told me about Resonance Repatterning. I was on the website all day absorbing everything I could until I believed that this was the work I wanted to do and learn. There was only one practitioner in San Diego, Shirley Lanyi. I called her and made an appointment and asked if they would be doing a training here in San Diego. She told me that they were trying to put one together. Between then and the beginning of my training in August 2007 I had received 13 sessions with Shirley and read Chloe's book twice.

What does Resonance Repatterning mean to you?

My heart is stirred with appreciation first of all to my Heavenly Father for creating us so that given the right circumstances and environment our bodies and minds can heal themselves like a wound on the hand. I also appreciate and am in awe of the genius, love, determination, dedication and empathy that Chloe demonstrates in being able to come up with this amazing process that identifies and transforms unconscious patterns that made my life so tormented and now has brought relief from the programming of one of the worst possible abuses. I honor her and send her love and abundant blessings. I was certified on August 31, 2009 and feel privileged to be able to share this work with others so they can connect to their own power and help create positive change for themselves and others.

What are some examples of sessions that stand out in your life?

The sessions that have stood out for me are the ones that have directly brought me relief from the cult and sexual abuse in my childhood. I also had the privilege of receiving the Birth Process Repatterning with Chloe and several other participants that created new neural pathways of a perfect birth experience that is embedded in my brain. I am so thankful to all of you who helped create that with me.

What would you like to see the RPA do for its' newest members?

Please continue the encouragement and direction that you are providing in these journals. They have such an empowering effect on us and take us through other doors of exciting growth. They offer many gems; for instance, the article and DVD "The Living Matrix". Thank you.

Do you have a motto? What five words describe you?

Love for God and neighbor, and willingness to change and grow.

Is there something special about you that you'd like to share?

Needless to say we're eager to hear.

Remember all the important answers I was looking for from a religious point of view? Well, I received them and more than I ever thought possible. When I was 23 two people came to my door and asked me if I wanted to study the Bible at no charge in my own home. I said yes. Every question I asked they would open the Bible and show me the answer. When I questioned the translation they were using they brought other translations and showed me the same answers. I was so excited with what was being revealed to me and wanted to tell everyone I knew so I was baptized at age 25. For the past 37 years I have voluntarily and consistently studied, preached and taught Bible truths of the good news of God's Kingdom Government that will soon bring an end to all suffering and replace the negative system of things with a Peaceful New World.

Thank you for sharing your story of tremendous challenge and healing. It surely speaks to the amazing changes that are made manifest through the process of Resonance Repatterning and we rejoice with you in the work you can provide for others' well-being.

Q: I recently heard the saying, "The money is in the list." In terms of marketing can you elaborate on this?

A: "The List" is your mailing list of clients and potential clients and it is one of your business's most important assets. Whether you send out email or snail mail, keep growing your list. But make sure you do it in a responsible way. If you're building an email list, gone are the days when you could just put people on your mailing list. Not only is this bad "netiquette" but it's also against the Federal CAN Spam Act which sets requirements for sending commercial email. The Federal Trade Commission's website at: <http://www.ftc.gov/bcp/edu/pubs/business/ecommerce/bus61.shtm> outlines what you need to do to be in compliance with CAN Spam.

It's not difficult to comply with these regs and doing so will make you a reputable business person in the eyes of the public. A couple of the basic requirements are that you need to get people's permission and always have a way for them to unsubscribe from your list. Don't assume that because you are on someone's list that it's ok for you to put them on your list without their permission.

Getting people's permission is good for your practice, too. From a marketing perspective, bigger is not always better when it comes to mailing lists. A small list of responsive people who are interested in your services is likely to bring in more sales than unsolicited mailings to a large list of cold prospects.

Think of your mailing list as a way to build relationships with people. Send people valuable information that they can use. Use your mailing list to educate people about the benefits they can get from your work. Let people know what services you offer. If you use your list to develop relationships with people they will get to know you, like you, and trust you, and ultimately buy from you.

Q: What would you say to practitioners who are experiencing hopelessness and struggle right now regarding growing their practices?

A: I would say do not get sucked into the mass consciousness' limiting belief that the economy is bad and nobody has any money to spend on your services. In a July, 2009 newsletter, the National Center for Complementary and Alternative Medicine cited data that shows a very bright picture for practitioners of complementary and alternative medicine (CAM). Studies show that you are at the forefront of a growing field and that this trend will continue.

If you need proof, take a look at these numbers: Approximately 38 percent of all American adults use some form of CAM. According to a 2007 government survey, Americans spent \$33.9 billion on complementary and alternative medicine. In the U.S. alone, adults made an estimated 354.2 million visits to CAM practitioners (that's you!). Here's a quote from the study's lead author, "These data indicate that the U.S. public makes millions of visits to CAM providers each year and spends billions of dollars for these services.... While these expenditures represent just a small fraction of total health care spending in the United States, they constitute

a substantial part of out-of-pocket health care costs.” <http://nccam.nih.gov/news/2009/073009.htm>

I can attest from own experience that Resonance Repatterning is a viable career choice. When I took my first seminar, I knew virtually nobody who believed in energy healing. I had zero contacts in this field and no idea how I was going to meet the certification requirements of giving 75 sessions -- never mind finding people who would be willing to pay me for sessions on a regular basis. But the fact is my practice has grown every year since I started doing this work. Last year in the depths of the “Great Recession” my practice brought in more money than I have ever earned in any year in my previous careers, including law. And I expect this to continue. I say this not to brag, but to show you that with commitment and perseverance success can be yours, too.

Make the commitment and don’t give up. This is a great time to be building your practice because the energy is supporting new models and new ways of doing business. You are at the forefront of the new consciousness and the new economy. There are successful full-time practitioners supporting a nice living through their practices. If you feel like you need some guidance find one whose business model matches the way you want to practice and hire them to mentor you.

Unplug from the mass fear about the economy. Connect with your vision and purpose in why you are doing this work. This will help to keep you motivated. While it’s true that a lot of people are struggling, it’s also true that you have an important and unique service that can shift people out of this mess. Right now, more and more people are awakening to the possibilities of energy healing and they are looking for alternatives to help them navigate through the crumbling status quo. People are more

open, receptive and ready for your work than they've ever been before.

Here's a great quote from Abraham-Hicks that I have on my wall: "I expect that I will prosper even more during these economic times. These are boom times for me!" Get ON for this. The world needs you and you can create the kind of practice that supports you on every level. Resonance Repatterning is the perfect tool to help you do it. Use it! And don't give up.

ON THE MOVE AND TAKING ACTION

From the beginning of 2010, there have been over 40 reported earthquakes around the world. METAL ELEMENT: Family Systems entered in regards to exclusion on the planet of particular groups who over time historically have fought for freedom, sovereignty and dignity. The separation from World Markets or opportunity for voice certainly speak loudly in these cases. Grieving and great loss experienced was given space in repatterning. In this place, valuing support from spirit shifted so that there could be resonance with greater access to that which allows for clarity and ability to vision the future .

WATER ELEMENT: When the tsunamis after the Chile earthquake expanded across the Pacific, the message of Water Element's potential for non-coherence took the air waves for a day. They were prepared and took action when warned ahead of time. The ability to initiate, move through and persevere with requests from participants in regards to help in Chile opened the process to move forward with focusing on relief and rescue in tsunami areas on the coast of Chile.

WOOD ELEMENT: Anger and frustration in the face of these challenging experiences accessed internal resonance in moving from the inability to see into optimism and hope as they moved out of the first response. As sessions progressed, they worked with support for long term solutions.

FIRE ELEMENT: I heard a few people say, "It's just the Earth going through menopause." The Earth is going through a number of changes in regards to warming and shifting ecologically, socially and globally. The thought doesn't escape either that in Chinese Medicine, Triple Heater gets involved with the issues of temperature of the body and concerns itself in the areas of connection to groups. The loss of friends, family, leaders, and meaningful relationships cannot be underestimated. Sessions built on connection of friends, family and community worked with the purpose of resonating with inner home.
